



## **STAFF REPORT**

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### **Discussion and direction regarding Council Intergovernmental Agency Assignments**

July 22, 2003

Honorable Mayor and Council Members:

#### **Summary**

City council members serve on various Intergovernmental Committees and Commissions representing the City of Belmont. Annually these assignments are reviewed and modified when necessary. With the addition of Councilmember Feierbach following the June election, Council may wish to review the assignments for potential modification prior to the annual organization in December.

#### **Background and Discussion**

Councilmembers are assigned to various Intergovernmental Committees and Commissions in the County of San Mateo on an annual basis. Some of these assignments are historically assigned to the Mayor and Vice Mayor, so those assignments automatically change yearly. When the four-member Council modified the list in January of this year, all assignments were made, and none were left vacant for the winner of the June special election. Council may wish to review the assignments at this time and make modifications where desired in order to give an assignment to Councilmember Feierbach. Council should be mindful of the fact that changes will be forthcoming at its yearly reorganization in December, especially since Mayor Wright will not be seeking re-election in November.

#### **Fiscal Impact**

There is no fiscal impact.

#### **Recommendation**

Council should review the current assignments and make modifications where desired.

**Alternatives**

Keep assignments as they currently exist and wait to make modifications at the yearly reorganization of the Council in December.
