ORDINANCE AMENDING BELMONT FIRE
PROTECTION DISTRICT ORDINANCE 1980-2

The Board of Directors of the Belmont Fire Protection District does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Belmont Fire Protection District Ordinance 1980-2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 1980-2
AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE TIME AND PLACE OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF
THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE BELMONT FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Belmont Fire Protection District as follows:

Section 1: The regular meetings of the Board of Directors of the Belmont Fire Protection District shall be held quarterly on the fourth Tuesday of April, July, October and January at the Council Chambers of the Belmont City Council at One Twin Pines Lane, Belmont, California.

Section 2: The Board of Directors shall meet for the purpose of conducting study sessions at such times and places as may be designated by resolution or motion duly adopted by the Board of Directors.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be published once in a newspaper of general circulation in the County of San Mateo, and shall within fifteen days after its passage, be posted on the bulletin boards at the following three public places in the City:

1. City Hall
2. Post Office
3. Fire Station No. 1

Section 4: Severability. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Board of Directors of the Belmont Fire Protection District hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion may be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

Section 5: Pursuant to Section 36937 of the Government Code of the State of California, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its final passage.
