MOTION DESIGNATING VOTING DELEGATE FOR LEAGUE OF CALIFORNIA CITIES ANNUAL CONFERENCE

Honorable Mayor and Council Members:

Summary

The League of California Cities has requested that each city designate a representative and an alternate for the Annual Business Meeting held during the Annual Conference in San Francisco from October 6-8, 2005.

Background

In prior years, either the City Attorney or an attending City Councilmember has been delegated to represent the City of Belmont at the League of California Cities' Annual Meeting. Last year Mayor Warden attended this conference as the delegate, and former City Attorney Savaree was the alternate. As of this writing, Mayor Warden and Councilmember Bauer are scheduled to attend this year's Conference. City Attorney Zafferano will not be attending.

Discussion

It should be noted that, per the Voting Procedures (see attached), if neither the voting delegate nor alternate is able to attend the Business Meeting, the voting delegate or alternate may pass the voting card to another official from the same city by appearing in person before a representative of the Credentials Committee to make the voting exchange.
