Notice Inviting Sealed Proposals or Bids

LYALL WAY PAVEMENT REHABILITATION
CITY CONTRACT NUMBER 465B

The City of Belmont hereby publishes, by two successive insertions in the San Mateo Times, a newspaper circulated in said City and published in San Mateo County (there being no newspaper published in said City), a notice inviting sealed proposals or bids for City Contract Number 465B, LYALL WAY PAVEMENT REHABILITATION and referring to the Plans and Specifications on file in the Office of the City Clerk, the first of which publications shall be at least ten (10) days prior to the time fixed for opening bids.

SEALED BIDS will be received at the Office of the City Clerk, One Twin Pines Lane, Suite 375, Belmont, CA (hereinafter the City) until **2:00 PM on October 4, 2005**, at which time they will be publicly opened and read for performing work as follows:

The Contractor shall furnish all materials, equipment, tools, labor and incidentals necessary to complete the work shown on the plans and described in the specifications in a satisfactory and workmanlike manner to remove 7" of existing street section and replace with deep lift asphalt concrete, repair various sections of curb, gutter and sidewalk, raise manholes to grade, place striping, and install concrete curb ramps.

Bidders may obtain the bidding documents, plans and specifications at Belmont City Hall, Permit Center, One Twin Pines Lane, Suite 110, Belmont, CA 94002 for a non-refundable charge of \$30.00 in the form of a check payable to City of Belmont. Add an additional \$5.00 for postage if you request bid package to be mailed.

Bidding procedures are prescribed in the bidding documents. Bids shall be executed upon the forms provided in the bidding documents. Bid guaranty in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the total bid dollar amount and conforming to the prescribed bidding procedures must be submitted with each bid as a guaranty to be forfeited should the bidder, if awarded the contract, fail to enter into the same, or fail to furnish in a timely manner the bonds and/or proof of insurance.

Pursuant to Section 1770, et. seq., of the California Labor Code, the successful bidder shall pay not less than the prevailing rate of per diem wages as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. Copies of such prevailing rate of per diem wages are available from the Director of Industrial Relations.

The successful bidder must insure that its policies and practices provide equal opportunity to all applicants and employees without regard to race, color, creed, sex, age, religion, ancestry, citizenship, national origin, handicap, mental condition, veteran or marital status. The successful bidder must comply with the Americans With Disabilities Act.

Pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 22300, for monies earned by the Contractor and withheld by the City to ensure the performance of the Contract, the Contractor, may, at its option, choose to substitute securities meeting the requirements of said Public Contract Code Section 22300.

All bidders shall be licensed under the provisions of Chapter 9, Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California to do the type of work contemplated in the project. In accordance with provisions of California Public Contract Code Section 3300, the City has determined that the Contractor shall possess a valid Class A "General Engineering Contractor" License at the time that the bid is submitted. Failure to possess the specified license shall render the bid as non-responsive.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Construction Labor and Material Payment Bond in the amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract price, as well as a Faithful Performance Bond in the amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract price.

Bid forms received after the designated time will not be accepted. No bidder may withdraw its bid for a period of thirty (30) days after the date set for the opening of bids. The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids, and to waive any irregularities in the bids.
