COUNCIL INTERGOVERNMENTAL ASSIGNMENTS FOR YEAR 2006

Honorable Mayor and Council Members:

Summary

City Councilmembers serve on various Intergovernmental Committees and Commissions representing the City of Belmont. These assignments are reviewed and modified annually following the reorganization of the Council and/or the swearing in of new Councilmembers.

Background and Discussion

Councilmembers are assigned to various Intergovernmental Committees and Commissions in the County of San Mateo on an annual basis. Some of these assignments have historically been assigned to the Mayor and Vice Mayor. The City Selection Committee appointments are made by Mayors or delegates from the various cities, and their meetings are conducted by the County of San Mateo staff.

It should be noted that on Page 3 of the 2005 List, both the Criminal Justice Council and H.E.A.R.T. (Housing Endowment and Regional Trust appear with "struck out" text. As Council is aware, the Criminal Justice Council has recently been disbanded, and the City of Belmont is no longer a member of H.E.A.R.T. These two will be eliminated from the 2006 list once the final assignments are made.

Additionally, if there are new or upcoming assignments that should be included for 2006, that information can be incorporated into the final 2006 Assignment List.

Staff has provided information regarding the organizations, compensation received, when the meetings are held and whether or not reading material is provided. The draft 2006 List (Attachment B) maintains the names of the current Councilmember assignments, other than those held by outgoing Councilmembers Metropulos and Bauer, in the event those assignments do not change.

Recommendation

Council should review the current assignments and make appointments to the various Commissions and Committees as appropriate. Staff will notify each organization via mail of the new Council assignments.
