DAVEY GLEN PARK SURVEY

Honorable Chair and Commissioners:

Summary

On March 11, 2008 the City Council directed staff to continue outreach efforts of the community in regards to the Davey Glen Park development project. City Council members suggested that a survey be conducted of nearby residents to better assess their desires or concerns over the potential park development site. City staff working closely with the Central Neighborhood Association has prepared a survey for your review.

Background

The City Council instructed staff to create a neutral survey to be mailed out to residents within Central Neighborhood as an opportunity to provide feedback towards the development of a one acre parcel dedicated as a future park site.

Residents within 1500 feet of the site will be mailed a survey and the results will be compiled by city staff to present to the City Council for further direction. Also, city staff has recently contacted a land surveyor to provide an estimate for setting boundary markers to assist the public, the Commissions and the City Council in viewing the exact boundaries of the one acre parcel.

Discussion

The Commission should review the survey and provide staff with any suggestions or modifications to the survey. The City Council is also providing staff with feedback on the survey before it is mailed to the residents.
