**Quarterly Report from Belmont-San Carlos Fire Department Chief Fry**

Chief Fry provided an update on the status of pending grant requests, including new grant applications for training and for the Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) program. The Belmont-San Carlos Fire Department has sent strike teams to several of the fires around the State, and none of the crews has experienced any injuries. He added that Fire Inspector Palisi's services have been requested to investigate some of these fires. Reimbursement will be requested to cover the costs of sending the teams, and he noted that some monies have already been received.

Chief Fry indicated that recruitment is underway to fill a firefighter/paramedic position, and a conditional offer has been made. The Fire Academy begins in the fall. In addition, there are promotional opportunities within the department. Receipt of the new fire truck is forthcoming within a few weeks.

President Lieberman expressed his thanks to the Chief for his efforts in turning the department around.
