City Hall Lobby ADA Compliance/Customer Service Remodel

City Hall will be undergoing a transformation in the coming weeks, which will include improvements of the 1st and 3rd floors of City Hall to address ADA compliance and enhance the customer experience (facilities, information, ease of use). During this time, the Permit Center will be temporarily relocated to the 3rd Floor of City Hall, as there will be visible construction activities taking place in the lobby. New signage will be in place to appropriately redirect customers to the relocated permit center. Construction is anticipated to begin Monday, July 9th and the contractor has indicated a preliminary, 60-day construction schedule (September completion timeframe). Informational brochures providing more detailed information on the project, including interim Permit Center accommodations, are available on the City's website and in the City Hall lobby.

Parks

Preparations are underway at the Sports Complex Marina Field for the annual District 52 Little League Tournament beginning this weekend. In preparation, the hardscape, bleachers, and buildings have been washed, and the sports turf has received some attention, including irrigation adjustments and infield grading and grooming. The District 52 tournament hosts peninsula teams from Pacifica to Palo Alto. Come out and enjoy a ball game!

Several irrigation valves were run over by a vehicle on the median on Ralston Avenue near Belmont Canyon Road. Staff repaired and replaced the irrigation valves and water was restored to the system.

General maintenance included graffiti removal from multiple surfaces throughout Twin Pines Park and Barrett Community Center. In addition, shrubs and trees were trimmed throughout Twin Pines Park.



Several trees were also planted in the Sterling Downs neighborhood. The trees are replacing dead and declining trees that were removed.
