## City Hall Lobby ADA Compliance/Customer Service Remodel Progress

Phase II of this ADA compliance project has been completed, as the Permit Center has successfully moved back down to the Lobby this week and is open to the public. One of the large display monitors was mounted in the Lobby waiting area; the second monitor is on order and will be installed in the coming weeks. Painters will be returning to spot paint the main stairwell, as well as any necessary touchups in the Permit Center. Staff is working with the contractor to address remaining punch list items. As previously reported, given the unique issues the project team has been dealing with regarding the transaction drawer for the PD after-hours window, the project was split into 3 phases. Phase III will address the PD interior lobby and the night window. Staff believes to have found a successful solution and is working with the contractor to implement the work. The Grand Opening of the new Permit Center is scheduled for the December 11<sup>th</sup> City Council meeting.

### **Housing Endowment and Regional Trust (HEART)**

Housing Endowment and Regional Trust (HEART) of San Mateo County launched a new initiative to help homeowners building Green and Livable Accessory Dwelling Units in an effort to create more affordable housing units in the County. HEART was awarded a climate protection grant to develop designs for green accessory dwelling units (ADUs) that homeowners can download for free and build on their property. ADUs (sometimes known as second units or granny flats) are smaller than a primary structure in terms of size and can be built inside the main home, attached to it or even as a detached structure. HEART will be holding two open house event-- November 28 in Redwood City and November 29 in Millbrae. General ADU information and resources will be available to the public, primarily from Home for All's Second Unit Center and from HEARTS green ADUs program.

### **Are you interested in an Accessory Dwelling Unit? (Also known as granny flat or secondary unit)**

With custom Accessory Dwelling Unit (ADU) designs costing upwards of \$30,000 and taking months to develop, HEART, a nonprofit organization, sees an opportunity to increase the number of environmentally friendly ADUs built by providing homeowners with **free designs!**

The plan will provide a framework to restore the natural function of the watershed and protect people and places from flooding. The plan will also identify and discuss flood-resilient solutions, funding, and additional public benefits such as:



Water Quality Enhancements



Green Infrastructure



Potential for Groundwater Recharge

## WHY CREATE A FLOOD MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR BELMONT CREEK?


Flooding occurs between Old County Road and Industrial Road and continually impacts residents and businesses. The creek has been studied and analyzed for capacity deficits, erosion, and bank stability.

Today's system has capacity for the 10 year storm, which has a 10% probability of occurring any year. With community input, the Flood Management Plan is looking to protect for larger storm events.



Implementing multi-beneficial flood resilient solutions for larger flood events will save community millions in future storm recovery costs.








### Upper creek cross-section example

## Project Update/Traffic Advisory

### Ralston Avenue Sewer Rehabilitation Project Phase II

**November 26, 2018 and November 27, 2018** – Notre Dame Avenue between Ralston Avenue and Clee Street will be closed. The drill and mixing system will be set up at Notre Dame Ave and Ralston Ave. In order to be able to successfully pull 800' of 24" pipe the contractor needs to have everything prepared on Monday. The pipe will be connected to the reamer head and set up in the insertion pit at the proper elevation to begin reaming. The traffic control will remain in place overnight Monday so that the contractor can begin reaming and pulling the pipe on Tuesday morning at **5:00 AM**. Once the process starts on Tuesday morning, the contractor will not be able to stop until the entire 800' of pipe is in the ground. The contractor will then remove the reaming head from the pipe and pull the pipe into the manhole alignment. The drill and mixing system will be removed from Ralston Ave and placed in the staging area on Notre Dame Ave. The traffic will be opened up for Notre Dame Ave.

**November 28, 2018 to December 4, 2018** – the contractor will only be utilizing the median on Ralston Ave to rehabilitate the manholes and reconnect the laterals. Asphalt will be restored and any stripping will be replaced.
