

Mandatory Commercial Recycling

California Assembly Bill 341 (AB 341) requires all businesses that generate four (4) or more cubic yards of garbage per week and multi-family complexes with five (5) or more units to arrange for recycling collection services.

Businesses include, but are not limited to, office buildings, retail, restaurants, non-profits, government offices and schools. Multi-family complexes include apartments, townhomes and condominiums.

The purpose of the law is to:

- Divert waste from landfills
- Reduce greenhouse gas emissions

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Mandatory Organics Recycling

The mandatory **Commercial Organic Waste Recycling Law - AB 1826**

became effective on January 1, 2016 and requires businesses and multi-family complexes (with 5 or more units) that generate specified amounts of organic waste (compost) to arrange for organics collection services.

AB 1826 requires businesses and multi-family complexes to start recycling organic waste (compost) by the following dates:

April 1, 2016

Generators of 8 or more cubic yards of organic waste per week

January 1, 2017

Generators of 4 or more cubic yards of organic waste per week

January 1, 2019

Generators of 4 or more cubic yards of solid waste per week

Regulatory Requirements

AB 1826 requires businesses to separate and recycle the following types of organic waste:

- Food scraps
- Green waste/
Yard trimmings
- Non-hazardous, non-treated wood waste
- Food-soiled paper and cardboard



To comply with AB 1826, businesses and multi-family complexes must separate organic waste and:

- **Subscribe** to the BizSMART organics (Compost) collection service provided by Recology San Mateo County or a similar service provided by another vendor; **or**,
- **Recycle** organic waste onsite, or self-haul organic waste for recycling; **or**,
- **Sell or donate** the generated organic waste.

Multi-family Complexes

Multi-family complexes (with 5 or more units) must arrange for recycling services for organic waste with the exception of food waste and food-soiled paper.
